Submission and Review Process

The papers must be submitted ONLINE using single column in standard format (maximum 10 pages) through Easy Chair link. Standard instructions for writing papers paper is 12 point times new roman with line spacin 1, A4 format 6 pages. Running headings with 12 bold. First page will contain title, author information. The second page will contain title again and abstract and others contents of the paper. The submitted paper must be complete in all respects and must include results, figures, references etc. Review process will be double blind. PC will reject papers without review if the submission is not in proper format. Plagiarism of any form will lead to outright rejection of the paper.

- At least two independent reviewers will review and approve a paper
- A maximum of 10 papers will be assigned to a single reviewer
- All the review reports to be send to the respective authors
- Easy Chair weighted score to be used for making list of accepted papers.

The paper submission is through online using Easy Chair Submission System. The review will also be done through Easy Chair. Easy Chair weighted scoring system will be followed for preparing list of accepted papers. Acceptance and Rejection information will also be send through Easy Chair.

The Camera-Ready paper needs to be submitted by 15th September 2021 through Easy Chair. The Proceedings will not be published by any publication house. One souvenir will be published which will contains the Title, Authors details and abstract of the accepted papers. Top twelve-thirteen accepted and presented papers will be uploaded into this Special Issue of IETE Journal of Research, "IoT, Sensor Networks and Block Chain Technology for Smart Cities and Societies".

Prior to the acceptance of the paper, we shall check the plagiarism using Turnitin Software and it will be clearly spelt into the acceptance letter that if more that 10 % similarities are found the paper will be rejected at any stage.

To prepare the extended version Requirements are

- 1. Change the title
- 2. Change the abstract (at least 40% additional work is to be reflected)
- 3. Proposed work/methodology --> at least 40% additional work with comparison of improvement with the presented paper
- 4. Results of enhanced methodology (at least 40% additional results as compared to the presented paper)

- 5. Comparison with existing reported literature and at least one or two improvements has to be reported
- 6. Future scope for additional work needs to be proposed
- 7. State of the art reference (upto July 2021) needs to be provided and authors may delete the old references
- 8. Plagiarism/ similarities should not exceed 10 % in total and should not be more than 5% from a single source.

The authors will be asked to carefully consider the above mentioned 8-points, and submit the manuscript into the special issue of IETE Journal of research.
